#### REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration for SAFE is now open. Once you have completed the following, your child will be ready for his/her first day.

1. To register, please complete & return a 2018-2019 SAFE registration packet to the Rocky Mount YMCA. (Packet can be found at the main Y or download from our website: [www.franklincountyyymca.org](http://www.franklincountyyymca.org))
2. Registration fee (outside of Early Bird Special) and first week's fee will be due upon enrollment.
3. Please be prepared to submit a copy of your child's School Entrance Physical Examination, Immunization form, and Birth Certificate, unless already on file at the Y.

#### QUALITY STAFF

SAFE staff is selected based on educational background, and commitment to working to develop children. We maintain a ratio of at least one counselor for every 18 children (grades K-5) and one counselor for every 10 children (for Pre-K). Both site leaders and assistants maintain certifications in child safety throughout the year. Childcare coordinator, Jamie Stump and Childcare Director, Hope Vaccaro are also here to ensure that the safety and well being of each child is met.

#### SCHEDULE

##### BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL HOURS MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

\*SUFFICIENT ENROLLMENT REQUIRED FOR ALL SITES

##### BEFORE SCHOOL HOURS:

Serving: Rocky Mount (at the Rocky Mount Y) Boones Mill, Windy Gap, Burnt Chimney, & Dudley from 6:00 AM until 8:30 AM.

##### AFTER SCHOOL HOURS (UNTIL 6:00 PM):

Serving: Ferrum (at the Ferrum Y), Rocky Mount & Lee Waid (at Rocky Mount Elementary), Boones Mill, Windy Gap, Burnt Chimney, Dudley, & Glade Hill Elementary Schools.

#### BUS SCHEDULE & TIMES

ROCKY MOUNT, LEE WAID, & FERRUM ONLY

**Rocky Mount (BEFORE):** Parents will drop children off at the YMCA in Rocky Mount for Before School care. Bus will pick-up children at 8:00 AM and transport them to Rocky Mount Elementary

**Lee Waid (AFTER):** Bus will pick-up children from Lee Waid (after dismissal) and transport them to Rocky Mount Elementary for After School care. (Pick-up is at Rocky mount Elementary.)

**Ferrum (AFTER):** Bus will pick-up children from Ferrum Elementary (after dismissal) and transport them to the Ferrum Y. (Pick-up is at Ferrum Y.)

All children must be picked-up at their designated location (school or Y) by 6:00 PM.



#### WHEN SCHOOL IS OUT... THE Y IS IN!

On days of scheduled early dismissal, the YMCA will operate from the time of dismissal until 6:00 PM at our sites. If school closes early due to weather, SAFE will not be in operation. On days when school is closed (for entire day) due to weather, an out-of-school "Fun Club" will be held at the YMCA in Rocky Mount for an additional fee. Stop by to register for our FUN CLUB PROGRAM! Registration fee is waived for SAFE participants.
