

Y CHILDWATCH

Our first and foremost concern is quality care for your child. Please read these Childwatch Guidelines, which are based upon recommendations from our risk management consultants. We appreciate your cooperation with our effort to provide a positive experience for you and your child while using our facilities.

- Childwatch is intended for children ages 2 months through 5 years old. Children 6 years old and older can use the Essig Youth Center next door. Please consult a Member Services Associate for hours of operation.
- We strive to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all children. If your child has special needs which require extra attention we ask that you speak to the Member Services Director before dropping the child off. If it is necessary to discipline your child, the "time out" method is used.
- Childwatch privileges are limited to the time that the parent is working out at the YMCA. Please do not leave the building.
- For the well-being of others, children with fevers and/or contagious illnesses cannot be allowed in the Childwatch area.
- Payments for Childwatch cards are made at the Member Services desk. Please present card to Childwatch attendant upon arrival.
- There will be a sign in sheet available. Please list your name, your child's name and the area of the building you plan to use. Your child will not be permitted to leave the Childwatch area until you return and sign him/her out.
- Childwatch attendants may not feed your children and OSHA Regulations do not permit employees to change diapers. We are unable to allow food or drink in the Childwatch area. The YMCA is not responsible for member's belongings.
- We may interrupt your workout if we need your assistance with your child.
- There is a limit of 8 children in the Childwatch area at one time and Childwatch care is provided on a first-come first served basis. **Each visit is limited to a maximum of 2 hours.**
- The YMCA thanks all our Childwatch parents for allowing us the privilege of caring for your children. As your partner in this important endeavor we ask that you pick up your child by the time Childwatch closes. If a child is picked up after the published Childwatch closing time, a late fee (\$1 for every 5 minutes after closing) will be charged. Thank you for helping us make the Childwatch program work for everyone!
