## **FRANKLIN COUNTY FAMILY YMCA FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SUMMARY**

The mission of the Franklin County Family YMCA is to build strong kids, strong families, and a strong community by offering programs and services that build spirit, mind, and body. At the YMCA we put Christian principles for living and relating into practice, impacting the lives of adults and especially youth and children with positive life experiences, seeking to make them better people.

Financial assistance is available to any qualified applicant based on need and availability of funds at the time of application. Assistance is provided on a sliding scale based on the Virginia Department of Social Services guidelines for determining levels of need. Additional personal information is requested and considered as part of the financial assistance application process.

Due to the generosity of YMCA donors and United Way funding, the YMCA is able to offer financial assistance to those in need. All financial assistance recipients are encouraged to submit a letter of appreciation or written testimonial regarding the gift they have received. The YMCA's fundraising efforts include sharing stories of this nature with existing and potential donors, as part of our efforts to continue to provide assistance to additional individuals and families in need. Names and confidential information will not be shared.

Individuals interested in applying for financial assistance must submit a completed Financial Assistance Application to the YMCA. Applications are reviewed and applicants are contacted by phone to schedule an interview. Persons making appointments are expected to be present and on time for this interview. If you are unable to be present for the appointment please be certain to call in advance of the scheduled time. Persons who arrive late without prior notification may have their interview rescheduled. Persons who miss their interview without notifying the YMCA in advance will be placed on the bottom of the Appointment Call List. Persons who miss two interviews may not be eligible for financial assistance.

A decision regarding your application will be made during your interview as to how much assistance the YMCA can provide. Based on demand and scheduling constraints, the process may take four weeks to complete. Applications for assistance with payment for specific programs should be submitted at least six weeks in advance of the program to avoid any delay in enrollment.
