Camp Red Hawk Day Camp welcomes boys and girls ages 5–14 years old (must have completed Kindergarten). Camp Red Hawk is a co-educational camp; however, male and female campers are assigned to groups of their own age and gender. The Camp Red Hawk Day Camp program takes place mostly outdoors and may not be suited for every child. Please make sure that your camper knows the nature of his/her upcoming experience. Parents may drop off as early as 6:00 a.m. and pick up as late as 6:00 p.m. Space is limited.

Registration fee\$35.00 one-time for 1st child, \$10.00 each additional child (non-refundable)
 Session fee\$93.00 per week (YMCA member)
 \$106.00 per week (program participant)

A deposit of \$10 per child per session—or maximum \$20 per family per session—is required with registration (non-refundable if two-weeks notice not received). Deposit(s) will be applied to the session balance. Session fees are due one week prior to each session. Financial assistance is available to those who are in need.
